

GRAFFHAM- ELSTED

15km, 9.5 m. Westbound ascent 200m Eastbound 150m



Tiny, tiny lanes, wonderful scenery, not too much climbing and pubs at Graffham, Heyshott, Cocking and (I think) Elstead.

I once nearly ran over a dog sleeping in the middle of the road on this section, which sums up why I like this route so much.

Despite what the map says about the route from Heyshot to Cocking it is a paved road, as is all of this section. Several of the villages have lovely churches, although they will probably be locked. Bepton's is particularly idyllic.

For navigation follow the map and watch the signs to each village. From east to west these are Graffham, Hoyle, Heshott, Cocking, Bepton, Didling (slightly off of the route) Treyford, Elstead.
