

PORTSMOUTH

3.5km level

Except for the section from 10-11 this part of the route is on Sustrans route 22. This is not a well designed route and it is easy to get lost. Allow more time than you think you need. The route is signposted, but be careful with metal signs showing the way. People do turn them round in towns.

1) Going east walk your bike from the ferry terminal alongside the station. You can get on just before point 2. Going west be warned that there is no ticket office. You need to have money ready for the machines. 2012 prices were £2.80 for adults, £1 for bikes (folded bikes free).

2) Going east turn left and follow the road round. There are bike lanes in the road. Going west turn right just before the bus station and walk your bike to the Gosport ferry terminal.

3) Straight across here, following the bus lane.

4) 90 degree turn here. Portsmouth and Southsea station is nearby.

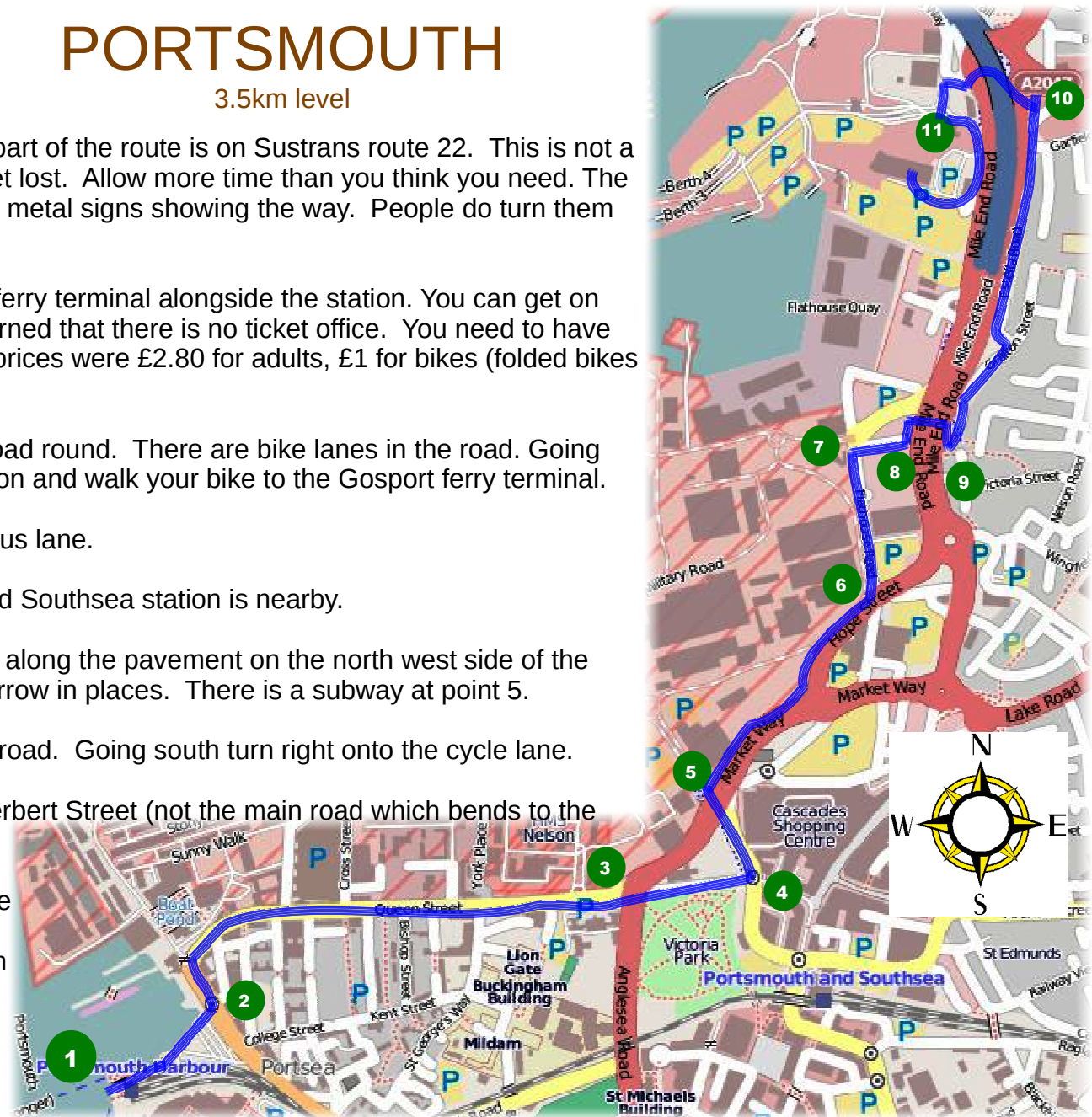
There is a cycle lane in both directions along the pavement on the north west side of the road between (5) and (6) It is quite narrow in places. There is a subway at point 5.

6) Going north turn left here, on to the road. Going south turn right onto the cycle lane.

7) Going north turn right here along Herbert Street (not the main road which bends to the right. Going South turn left.

8) Going north turn left at the end of the road, the other side of the flats, then right under an underpass. Going south emerge from the underpass and turn right at the end of a the flats.

9) Going north emerge from the



underpass and turn immediately sharp left on a narrow footpath. This joins a small street. Follow the signs until you reach a subway. Go under this and emerge in a rather desolate concrete area in the middle of a roundabout

Going south cycle to the end of the road and then follow the footpath straight ahead. Turn sharp right down the subway.

10) Going north aim for a subway exit to your left (west) (no signs) Go through the subway. Emerge the other side and follow signs to the terminal for your ferry. The main terminal is at point 11.

Going south the point at which you emerge will depend on which ferry you have arrived on. Aim for the roundabout underneath the elevated motorway to your east. Do not attempt to go round this roundabout but head for a pedestrian and cyclists underpass. Ride under this to reach point 10. Exit the concrete area using an underpass to your right, to the east of the motorway above you.
